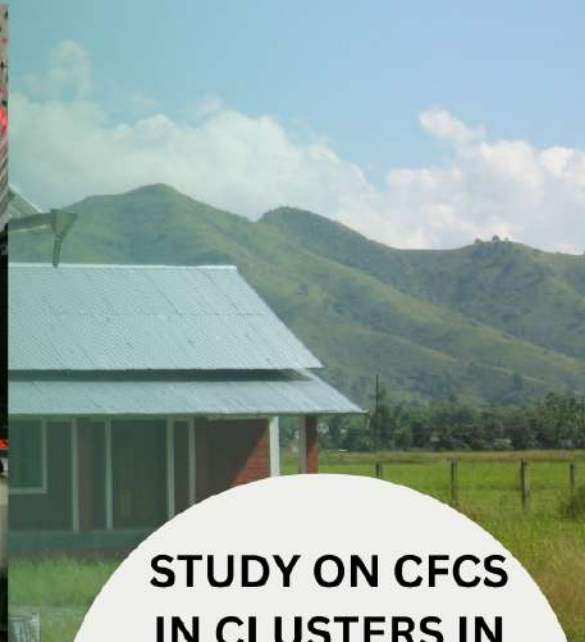

Schematic Support for Common Facility Centre (CFC) may be highest if

- 1. Demand for CFC is generated due to threat, followed by weakness and followed by strength/opportunity of the cluster.**
- 2. Land is owned by SPV, followed by land is on lease to the and followed by land received as donation by the SPV.**
- 3. For a pure CFC (only giving services for creation of cluster product), followed by mixed (giving services as well as making the cluster product) CFC.**
- 4. Higher the presence of cluster firms in the management committee of the CFC.**
- 5. Presence of an informed doer from among the cluster stakeholders, who is leading/guiding the process of CFC creation.**
